My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, we honour the Cross in our lives because Christ died upon it. By dying on it, Christ transformed the cross into an instrument of salvation from the symbol of humiliation and shame that it was. By Christ's death upon the cross, the cross has become the hope of the living, the symbol of resurrection for the dying, the key to eternal life for the righteous and the sure way to the kingdom of God for all His people. During this season of Lent our mother Church invites us to share deeply in the pression of Christ in the cross



invites us to share deeply in the passion of Christ, in the cross of Christ, so that we might share even more deeply the glory of the resurrection – both here and here-after.

From the cross Christ teaches us what is genuine value and what is false, what is really good and what is outright evil, what a monstrous thing sin is in the sight of our loving God and what path leads to eternal life. You are invited to participate in the Stations of the Cross to journey with Jesus through quiet moments of music, prayer, thoughtful meditation and silent reflection.
